TOLLS SUSPENDED ON MDX EXPRESSWAYS

MIAMI, Fla., September 5, 2017 – MDX announces that it will suspend tolls on its five expressways effective at 5 p.m. today to facilitate evacuation prior to any impacts upon the arrival of Hurricane Irma. Governor Rick Scott issued an order today to toll agencies in Florida to suspend tolls until further notice due to the impending storm.

Motorists are urged to drive safely and slowly. MDX’s Road Rangers will be operating as usual, providing free roadside assistance to distressed motorists until winds reach speeds of 39 mph. Drivers can contact Road Rangers by dialing * FHP (347).

We will provide updates to this advisory as conditions change through the media and our website. MDX roads include SR 836/Dolphin Expressway, SR 874/Don Shula Expressway, SR 924/Gratigny Parkway, SR 112/Airport Expressway and SR 878/Snapper Creek Expressway.
