MDX and Elected Officials Team to Sell SunPass for \$8.36

Miami, Fla., May 20, 2007 – In conjunction with the June 22nd opening of the SR 836 / Dolphin extension west to 137th Avenue, MDX is teaming with local and state elected officials to sell SunPass transponders for \$8.36.

The 3-mile extension will provide drivers heading to and from west Miami-Dade with a more direct connection to central and downtown Miami, and ease traffic on heavily traveled surface roads like Flagler and S.W. 8th streets. The \$225 million extension will be the first SunPass only Open Road Tolling roadway in Miami-Dade County. Drivers will not need to slow down or stop to pay the \$0.25 toll.

SunPass transponders normally retail for \$25. To purchase one at the special sale price, residents must go to one of the 9 offices listed below only during the day and time indicated. There is a limit of two transponders per customer and only cash will be accepted.
