ICYMI: The Greater Miami Expressway Agency (GMX) Submits Voluntary Disclosure on Compassionate and Seamless Transition

MIAMI – September 12, 2023 – The Greater Miami Expressway Agency (GMX) submitted a formal filing to Electronic Municipal Market Access (EMMA) on the status of the transition to GMX.

GMX Interim Executive Director Torey Alston worked with his transition team to share an update on prior litigation, daily operations, financial stability and overall governance. The GMX governing board continues to provide oversight during this process.

"The GMX transition of operations continues to guarantee, first and foremost, continuity of services. On the administrative end, all payroll and vendor payments have been uninterrupted and processed accordingly, and we are currently reviewing previous policies, procedures and agreements," said Alston.
