MIAMI-DADE EXPRESSWAY AUTHORITY (MDX) TO HOST PUBLIC KICKOFF MEETING *Community Encouraged To Provide Input on Proposed SR 874 Ramp Connector To SW 136TH Street*

MIAMI, Fla., March 31, 2010– The Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) has scheduled a Public Kickoff Meeting to allow the community to discuss the SR 874/Don Shula Expressway Ramp Connector to SW 136th Street as part of the Project Development and Environment Study (PD&E). The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, April 6, 2010, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Country Walk Club House, 14601 Country Walk Drive in Miami.**

The SR 874 Ramp Connector to SW 136th Street project proposes an access ramp from the terminus of SR 874 to SW 136th Street. The meeting will give property owners, residents and interested parties an opportunity to receive information and provide input on the project during this phase of study. Participation and input is strongly encouraged and appreciated.
