MDX SR 874/Don Shula Expressway

As part of the SR 874 Ramp Connector to SW 128th Street project, the following lane closures are scheduled:

Mainline Complete Closure

All lanes on southbound SR 874 from south of SW 104th Street/Killian Parkway to the Florida's Turnpike/SR 874 interchange will be closed for equipment relocation on **Tuesday, March 2 and Wednesday, March 3 from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. each night.** Drivers should follow posted detour signs. **Detours:**

Drivers traveling southbound on the SR 874 intending to connect with the Turnpike will be detoured to:

- Exit at the southbound Off-Ramp to West SW 104 Street/Killian Parkway, then
- Continue west along Killian Parkway until SW 117 Avenue, then
- Turn left (south) along SW 117 Avenue, then
- Turn right (west) on SW 120 Street and continue to the southbound Turnpike ramp at the 120 Street Interchange.

Lane Closures

Up to two lanes on northbound SR 874 from SW 120th Street to north of the Killian Parkway Interchange will be closed for asphalt paving operations on **Monday, March 1 through Thursday, March 4** from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night.

Single Lane Closure by Flagging Operation

Traffic eastbound and westbound on SW 128th Street will be stopped intermittently by flagging operations from SW 137th Avenue to the Cul-de-Sac at the east end of 128th Street, for signalization work and roadway construction on **Monday, March 1 through Friday, March 5 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. each day.**

Street Full Closure

SW 128th Street will be fully closed east of SW 122nd Avenue to the Cul-de-Sac at the end of SW 128th Street to perform bridgework. These closures might take place on **Monday, March 1 through Friday, March 5 from 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. each night.** Only local traffic will be allowed.

Single or Double Lane Closure

One traffic lane and if needed the left turn lane will be closed on both northbound and/or southbound SW 122nd Avenue from south of SW 126th Terrace to SW 129th Street to allow roadway work on **Monday, March 1 through Friday, March 5 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. each day.**

Single Lane Closure

One traffic lane of northbound and/or southbound SW 137th Avenue will be closed between SW 124th Street and SW 131st Street for paving and signal construction starting on **Sunday, February 28 through Friday, March 5 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. each day and 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. each night.**

Street Full Lane Closure

The intersection at SW 127th Avenue and SW 124th Street will have a full lane closure on both traffic directions, for roadway and drainage work from **Monday, March 1 through Friday, March 5 from 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. each night.** Drivers should follow posted detour signs. **Detours:**

Drivers going south on SW 127th Avenue can:

- Turn right on SW 120th Street and go west to SW 137th Avenue
- Turn left and go south to SW 128th Street
- Turn left and go east to SW 127th Avenue

Drivers going north on SW 127th Avenue can:

- Turn left at SW 128th Street and go west to SW 137th Avenue
- Turn right and go north to SW 120th Street
- Turn right and go east to SW 127th Avenue

- **Please note that all scheduled activities are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.**
